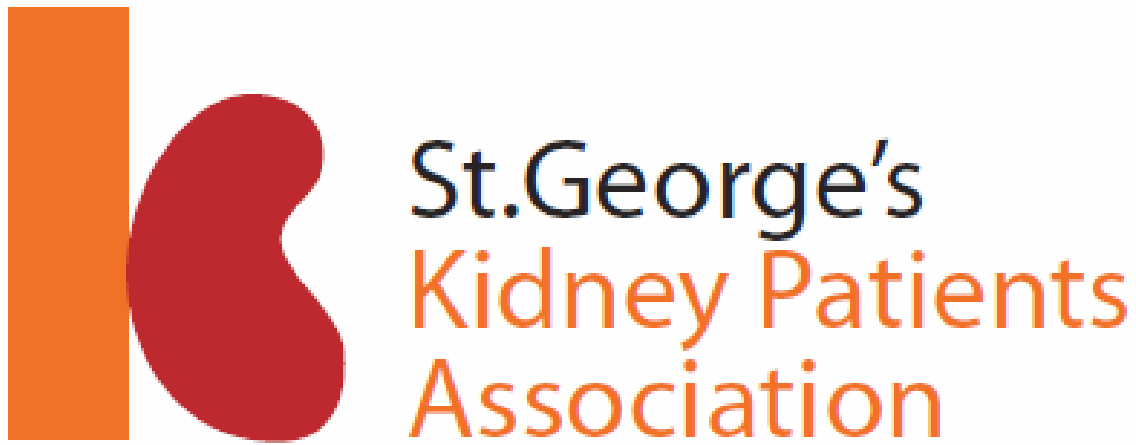

In recent years, the Charity has raised much needed funds for items such as:

- **Immunoadsorption machine** . . . . . to allow ABO incompatible transplants
- **Laparoscopic stack** . . . . . to enable key hole surgery for donor nephrectomy
- **Trasonic ultrasound machine** . . . . . for vascular access monitoring
- **Omnitract device** . . . . . for removing donor kidneys and transplantation
- **Lifeport machines** . . . . . to preserve kidneys
- **Body Composition Monitors (BCM)** . . . . . detects excess body fluid
- **Bladder scanners** . . . . . immediate high-resolution diagnostic images
- **New Dialysis chairs** . . . . . better comfort for the 4-5 hour treatment sessions
