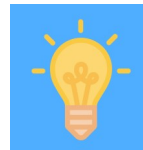

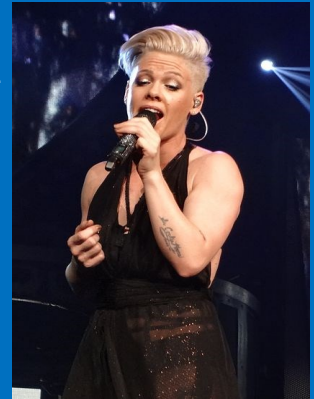


Coronavirus Survivors!
